The Manor's interior design draws inspiration from Xianghu culture, focusing on classical opera and blending historical heritage with modern style. The architectural space and the felt experience combine to create a secluded and luxurious resort ambiance.

















Liberty Manor enjoys a fantastic setting, surrounded by historic sites, leisure and entertainment facilities, and family-friendly vacation destinations. Among these attractions are the Kuahu Bridge Site Museum, exploring the history of the "108 ancient bridges" that connected the region's 8,000-year-old culture. Another attraction is Yuewangcheng, the former capital of the Yue state during the Warring States period, and Chengshan Square, which together tell the stories of King Goujian's defense against the Wu forces. A stroll through the Zhejiang Modern Ceramic Art Museum adds an artistic perspective, rounding out destinations that allow visitors to immerse themselves in the past and appreciate the present.

Rooms at the Manor are designed with the concept of "the world beyond the stage," including curved corridor designs resembling curtains, inviting you to step backstage. Each room's colorful wall decorations are reminiscent of the "cloud shoulders" of Yue Opera performers, while the exquisite ornamental verve and sublime furniture create an elegant resting space.

There are 156 rooms and suites starting from 45 square meters. Rooms are equipped with amenities, including Nespresso capsule coffee machines and JBL wireless charging Bluetooth speakers. Most rooms feature outdoor terraces, offering panoramic views of the picturesque lake or garden, allowing you to enjoy a peaceful lakeside experience that rejuvenates both body and soul.





Elysian All Day Dining Restaurant brings together Western and Chinese cuisines, along with local flavors. On offer are buffet breakfast, Western and Chinese set meals, and themed afternoon tea. Elysian's spatial design illustrates the beauty of a shimmering lake in the morning light, complemented by the picturesque view of the courtyard outside the window, allowing you to enjoy the dual pleasures of sight and taste.








CHINESE PRIVATE DINING ROOMS
